Is Malvern Retreat House open?

MRH is currently open with COVID guidelines in place. Visitors are welcome to visit the beautiful property of MRH. All are invited to join us on the third Sunday of the month for a Eucharistic Procession and Adoration beginning at 2pm.

Are you accepting Retreat Groups?

Yes. We are accepting retreat groups although capacity is limited and guidelines are in place. Several groups have returned to Malvern Retreat House and have welcomed our new safety guidelines.

What restrictions are in place at MRH?

Are Masks Required?

MRH follows the directive from the PA Gov office and masks are required.

How many guests can be onsite at MRH?

Malvern Retreat House follows the directives of federal, state and local authorities regarding occupancy limitations. Due to COVID-19, our capacity is limited by the required social distancing throughout our buildings. Our staff works with each group to implement Malvern guidelines while maximizing space while ensuring social distancing.

When do you expect to fully re-open?

MRH is in the first phase of our re-opening and we will continue to monitor information from state and local authorities and will update as needed.

Can I come to Malvern for daily mass? Does MRH have confessions available?

We are not currently having daily Mass at MRH. We do not offer regular confessions at MRH.
